

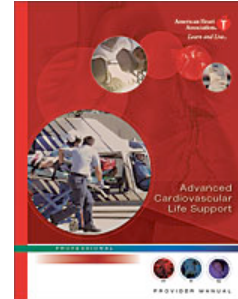
## Anesthesiology Resuscitation Elective Pre-Course Student Instructions and Information

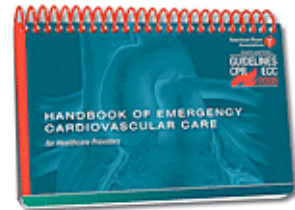

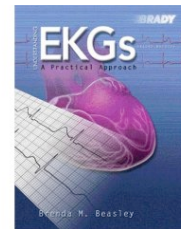
