METI Disaster Medicine Program Opportunities

- HPSD-21
 - Civilian and military focused
 - Creation of National Disaster training curriculum
- Updated Joint Commission standards (01/08) for hospital emergency management (all-hazards disaster preparedness)
- PAHPA
 - Focus on medical community for disaster preparedness
- Human Patient Simulators on AEL/SEL



METI Disaster Medicine Program Opportunities

- All local, State, Tribal and Federal and private (hospitals) agencies receiving federal dollars for disaster preparedness must integrate the following guidelines...
 - National Response Plan
 - NIMS Compliance
 - Hazard Vulnerability Assessments and National Planning Scenarios
 - Target Capabilities List
 - Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program



METI Disaster Medicine Program Funding Sources and Cycles

- **ASPR**
 - **Bioterrorism Hospital Preparedness Grant Program**
 - \$415,032,000.00
 - Current funding runs through 8/2008
 - Managed by each State or Jurisdiction
 - **Healthcare Facilities Partnership Program**
 - First year - \$25,000,000.00 awarded as grants from .5 - 2.5 million per awardees
 - Current funding runs through 8/2008
 - Managed ASPR



METI Disaster Medicine Program Funding Sources and Cycles

- **DHS**
 - **Homeland Security Grant Program (deadline 5/1/08)**
 - State Homeland Security Program - \$862 million
 - Urban Area Security Initiative - \$781 million
 - Only UASI areas eligible
 - Metropolitan Medical Response System - \$39 million
 - Only MMRS areas eligible
 - Citizens Corps Program - \$14.5 million
 - **Regional Catastrophic Preparedness Grant Program**
 - \$60 million additional funding to Tier I and II UASI urban areas for catastrophic event planning and preparedness activities



METI Disaster Medicine Program Funding Sources and Cycles

- **DHS (continued)**
 - **Emergency Management Performance Grant**
 - \$291 million (application deadline 3/1/08)
 - METI users can partner with EMA to support training and exercises
 - **Transit Security Grant Program**
 - \$388 million to enhance security and response capabilities to transit systems in high-threat urban areas

Component of METI Disaster Medicine Program

- **Simulators**
 - HPS
 - ECS with convulsions
 - iSTAN
- **Optional Equipment**
 - TDCK with Moulage kit
 - Portability Kit
 - Wireless Remote
 - Mannequin Carry Case
- **Learning Module**
 - Updated Disaster Medical Readiness (DMR) Learning Module
 - Based on National Planning Scenarios
 - Can be integrated to meet appropriate Target Capabilities
 - Separate treatment windows
 - Can be customized by user to meet local protocols and capabilities
